### Game Schedules....

To access your game schedule, **mark your attendance** and view your team roster, Log into your player's account on our website, [www.MiracleLeagueoftheTriangle.com](http://www.MiracleLeagueoftheTriangle.com).



**Weekly Attendance is expected:** Your team is counting on you!

- Unable to make it to a game? **Please mark your child unavailable by 5 p.m. Wednesday** online, using their player account. This is important for creating line-ups and recruiting volunteers. *The attendance system shuts down Wednesday night through Saturday.*
- If an emergency or unexpected situation arises after the Wednesday 5 pm deadline, please contact your coach. Their contact information is available on your player account.
- Parent/Guardian must always be present at the field throughout your child's game. Parents are expected to be the first responder in a case of illness, accident or injury to their child.



**Game Time: Arrive 20 minutes BEFORE game time** and report to the team tables. This time is used for buddies and players to get to know each other. Please be considerate of coaches, buddies, announcers, and teammates. Late arrivals can cause a lot of stress, especially for your player.

**After the game:** Parents should meet their child & Buddy at the gate *by the team's dugout* promptly at the end of the game. Note, a *parent/guardian must be present at the field at all times* throughout your child's game.



**INCLEMENT WEATHER:** Games will be played through light rain, unless conditions are deemed unsafe. Cancellations or postponements due to inclement weather will be posted across our home page at [www.MiracleLeagueoftheTriangle.com](http://www.MiracleLeagueoftheTriangle.com) and on Facebook as soon as a decision is made.

### Uniforms/Dress:

- Players must **wear this season's current jersey** and ball cap. Announcer use the uniform numbers to call out the correct player's name.
- Your child should wear athletic shoes (*no cleats or flip flops*) and other comfortable clothing (i.e. shorts, sweat pants) appropriate for playing ball.

### Nick names and songs:

- If you did not submit your music via the website prior to the first game, please submit it in mp3 format via email ([programs@miracleleagueofthetriangle.com](mailto:programs@miracleleagueofthetriangle.com)) or on a CD labeled with the *player's name, team name and song* title. Changes to music cannot be completed at the field on game day.
- **Changes should be given to your coaches or Miracle League staff** *once* per season. Please do not disrupt announcers to submit changes.



**Registration Fees:** Any outstanding registration fees will be collected at the first game (Check or Cash only) or can be paid via PayPal when logged into your player account.

**Medical Treatment:** Any medical treatment or nourishment should be provided off the field, outside of the dugout. No food or drinks allowed on field or in dugout other than water.



**No Pets:** Only identifiable service animals are allowed on the grounds. Please advise family and friends who come to watch the games of this rule.



**No Smoking or vaping:** Smoking/vaping is not allowed *anywhere* on Miracle League grounds.



**No Food or Drink:** Other than the water coolers provided, no food, gum or drinks are allowed on the ball field or in the dugout.



**No Littering:** Please use the trash receptacles provided so everyone can benefit from a tidy, clean environment.

### Special buddies:

- If your child has a specific, dedicated buddy who will be helping at each game, including a family member, that person must be registered online as a volunteer and request your child each season. The request should be made on the Miracle League website at least 48 hours prior to game time.
- *Only registered volunteers, coaches, staff and players are allowed on the ball field and in the dugouts without consent of Miracle League Staff.*
- All designated buddies are asked to check in at Volunteer Registration before going to the team table each week.

*For the safety of everyone on the field, only registered volunteers age 12 yrs. and older will be allowed on the field or in the dugout.*
